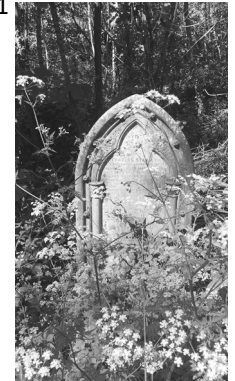

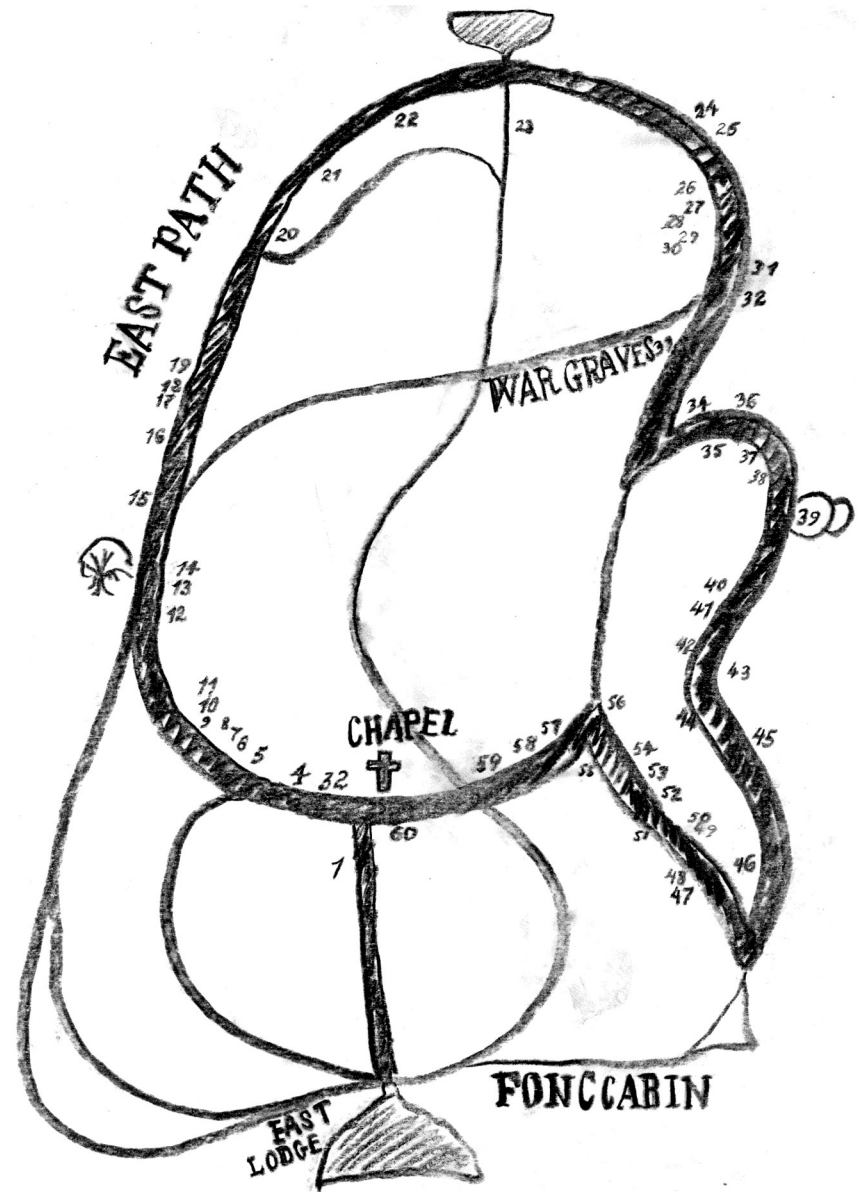

32 Two tired hands now rest.

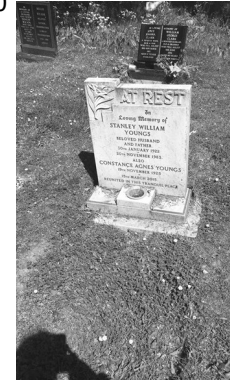
